Check-In Time: 8:00 AM – 10:00 AM

Show Time: 11:00 AM - Starting with Novice showmanship

Ages: 8/9 – 18 (4-H Age only) - Eligible for breed awards

- Showmanship Classes – Age 5-8/9 (novice); 9-10; 11-12; 13-14; 15-16; 17-18
- Monetary Awards for Showmanship – 1st-\$15; 2nd-\$10; Remainder of class ; \$5 each
(Must have Breeding Sheep entered in show to participate in Showmanship Classes)

Breeding Classes (Inclusive of All Registered Breeds)

Rams: Fall and Spring Lambs ONLY - Can Only Show one (1) Ram per Class (NO YEARLING CLASSES)

Ewes: Yearling: Fall & Spring Lambs - Can Show (2) Females per Class

Flock: Consists of 1 ram and 2 ewes (any age)

Show points counted on the three (3) top individual sheep for each exhibitor

Cumulative Points from ALL (4) shows, including the three (3) Breeding Shows (above) and the Ohio State Fair will count toward year-end awards.

Exhibitor must show at a minimum of three (3) shows to be eligible for Year End Awards

No requirement to show at the Ohio State Fair for Year End Awards

Entry Fee: \$12/Head or Flock, due at show check-in

Ownership: June 1st (Proof of Ownership must be provided at check-in)

- Sheep Must Be Registered or Present Evidence of Ability to Register
 - (Sale Receipt required if purchased at sales or private sales)
- For Points/Awards Exhibitor or Family or Farm **ARE REQUIRED** to be Ohio Sheep Improvement Association (OSIA) Members, applications are available at: www.ohiosheep.org
- Pay-out - Sliding Scale
 - Champion Ram and Ewe for All Breeds
 - Any Breed Exhibiting 10 or More Total Sheep will Receive \$20 For Each Champion
- All Breeding Sheep Must Carry Scrapie Identification Tags
- All Out of State Sheep Must Have Valid Health Papers
- Sheep Released After Completion of Show and Pen Clean Up if necessary

2017 OSIA LEAD Council Jr. Breeding Sheep Program Shows Point Rules

- Four (4) shows are available for points for 2017
 - Sunday June 4, 2017 - Hancock Co. Jr. Breeding show
 - Saturday June 10, 2017 - Richwood Jr. Breeding show
 - Saturday June 17, 2017 – Guernsey Co. Jr. Breeding Show
 - July 28, 2017 – August 6, 2017 - Ohio State Fair Jr. Breeding Sheep Shows
- All breed classes will be placed from Top to Bottom for Award Points Program
 - Premium payout will be on an established “**Sliding Scale**” System
- All shows, Hancock, Richwood, Guernsey Jr. Breeding shows and Ohio State Fair Junior shows will be single (1X) shows.
- Exhibitor will be required to show in a minimum of three (3) shows to be eligible for year-end awards.
- Points System:
 - One (1) point for participating in the class.
 - One (1) point for every sheep in the class regardless of the number in the class.
- Exhibitor, family, or farm must be an OSIA member, Family memberships (\$35.00) and Youth Memberships (\$15.00). OSIA Membership Forms available at www.ohiosheep.org
- Points will be online at the OSIA website, www.ohiosheep.org under OSIA LEAD Council.
- Year-End Awards will be awarded at a Year-End Awards banquet on October 15, 2017.
- Year-End Awards for each Showmanship division will be given based on a points system.
- There are six (6) divisions for Showmanship: 5-8/9 (novice division) and 8/9-10; 11-12; 13-14; 15-16; 17-18 - 4-H Age Only – All ages as of January 1, 2017
 - Showmanship premium payout: 1st - \$15.00; 2nd - \$10.00; Remainder of class - \$5.00
- Year End awards will be awarded for each breed represented based on points.
- A **MAXIMUM** of eight (8) sheep of each breed can be shown by an exhibitor – six (6) ewes and two (2) rams
- A **MAXIMUM** of three (3) animals will count toward the points in each breed per exhibitor.
- Breed champions will receive five (5) extra points and Reserve Champions will receive an extra three (3) points regardless of show.
- If an exhibitor does not show in Supreme show, they will forfeit all points accumulated at that particular show.
- Exhibitor will be **REQUIRED** to be at the head of the sheep unless two entries are in the same class.
- Novice Classes (ages 5-8/9 as of 1/1/2017) will be offered in both showmanship and breed classes
 - Novice Showman must show an individual or family owned ewe lamb only
 - The novice ewe lamb can only be shown by the novice exhibitor
 - Novice Breeding Classes will be divided by Meat Breed and Wool Breed entries.
- Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 901-19 will be enforced to guide our show rules.
- OSIA LEAD Council and Ohio Revised Code Ethics/Humane Treatment guidelines will be enforced.
- OSIA LEAD Council Code of Conduct will be enforced to guide our exhibitor conduct at the shows.
