- Involvement in sheep industry related legislative activities, including in 2023 major activity with Ohio State Fair/Ohio Exposition Center Taskforce, Ohio Meat Processing Grants, Ohio Department of Agriculture Animal Disease Laboratory (ADDL), Beginning Farmers Tax Program. Also instrumental in working with ASI to provide the much needed Coronavirus Food Assistance Program (CFAP) for lambs, sheep, and wool, and inclusion for wool payments in the Wool LDP Program.
- Providing educational opportunities to sheep, lamb, and wool producers, including the Buckeye Shepherd's Symposium, Buckeye Young Shepherd's Expo, Statewide Sheep Production Tour, etc.
- Providing sheep, lamb, and wool leadership programming through a council and committee structure, including but not limited to the Educational Programming, Public Policy, Youth Programming, Membership Marketing, Scholarships, Lamb and Wool Promotional Activities, and the OSIA LEAD Council.
- Engaging young sheep producers in the sheep industry through educational programming, the Ralph Grimshaw Memorial, Dr. Jack Judy Memorial, High Family Memorial and OSIA LEAD Scholarship Programs, Young Shepherd's Assembly Program and the Ohio Lamb and Wool Ambassador Program.
- Coordinating one of the largest lamb promotional efforts in the United States, the Ohio State Fair "Taste of Ohio Café" sells approximately 3,000 lbs. of Fresh American Lamb to consumers annually at the Ohio State Fair.

- Educating the Ohio and National legislators about the importance of Ohio's sheep industry and the economic contribution sheep, lamb, and wool farmers make to our state through personal meetings, events, and letters.
- Sponsorship of the wool promotional program, Ohio Make it With Wool (OMIWW), to promote the use of American produced wool, creating the best wool promotional programs in the United States.
- Working with Ohio's leadership and state agencies such as Ohio Department of Agriculture (ODA) and Ohio Department of Natural Resources (ODNR) to monitor and assess the impact on rules and regulations that may affect sheep farmers and the products they produce. - Representing Ohio's sheep, lamb, and wool farmers on state committees and advisory boards such as Ohio Livestock Coalition, ODA CAFF Advisory Board, Ohio Agricultural Council, Ohio Agriculture Conservation Initiative (OACI), Ohio Livestock Exhibition Committee and Ohio Livestock Nutrient Management Taskforce.
